For Teachers Working with Challenging Students

Strategies to Prevent Problems Before They Grow

Pat Belvel is offering teachers support in working with students struggling to maintain appropriate school behavior through solution focused thinking and research-based strategies. The most common challenges are: aggression, resistance, isolation (withdrawal), distractions, adult dependence. Some students are caught between their problems and appropriate school behavior and have not yet learned how to deal with their unmet needs.

These students have been called ‘target students’, children of challenge, youth at risk, and in fact, are “magnet students’ as they draw us to them and call for our help by disrupting the classroom environment and affecting teacher effectiveness.

Process

Pat will observe the student during the setting that is most problematic and will take data on the student every 30 seconds to determine which type of challenge is dominating. She will meet with the teacher to create a written plan of action and support teachers through the process.
